

T's & C's for Endless Pools

Swimming in an Endless Pool is fun and enjoyable, but pools can also be dangerous. Water presents a risk of drowning and injury can be sustained from hard pool surfaces or misuse of equipment. To ensure your safety and the safety and enjoyment of other pool users, Rec Centre management have established the following code of behaviour for all pool users.

Be aware that these pools are NOT supervised and we highly recommend pool users have a 'buddy' with them. All users do so at their own risk.

I understand and agree to comply with the following terms and conditions regarding the use of Rec Centre Endless Pools:

- All first time users of pools agree they will complete an induction session with a Rec Centre staff member before using pools.
- Pool users are requested to shower before entering pools.
- Maximum of two people per pool at any one time
- Children under 8yrs require written permission from Rec Centre management to use pools
- Children under 16 years are not permitted in swimming pool area unless actively supervised by a caregiver at least 16 years old.
- No swimming while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- No food is allowed in the pool area or drinks in the pool.
- Correct swimming attire must be worn: no jeans, street clothes etc.
- No running, jumping, diving or other dangerous behaviour in pool area.

On completion of session:

- Return any pool equipment to its designated area, return pool keys to reception and always ensure door is securely closed when leaving pool area.
- Always check the depth of water before entering pool, as each pool is a different depth.
- We recommend that swimmers with epilepsy, asthma, diabetes or a heart condition swim with a buddy.
- Please do not use pools if you have infected cuts, throat, nose, ear or eyes, or have had diarrhoea in last 48 hours.
- Rec Centre management reserve the right to close the pools for maintenance, cleaning or any other reason without prior notice.
- Bad language and poor behaviour will not be tolerated. Equipment, pools and other pool users are to be treated with respect.
- Failure to observe the above conditions will result in you being asked to leave the Centre.
- Any injuries or incidents in pool area must be reported to reception.
- Personal belongings are the owners responsibility and no responsibility will be accepted by Rec Centre for items alleged to have been lost or stolen on premises.
